All payments are billed through e-mail, are due on the first of the month and are delinquent if not in the office by the 10th of each month. Any unpaid balances past 30 days will be subject to potential suspension for your student. To prevent potential suspensions due to inability to continue monthly payments, please apply with SallieMae before you become 30 days past due. Withdrawing a student will result in added fees and all balances paid before records are released. \$700 of your tuition supports the annual purchase of curriculum and service fees. This amount is exempted when balances are pro-rated due to late registration or early withdrawal.

**\*Afterschool Program for Grades 6-12 3:30-5:30**  
 Students in grades 6-12 who are not picked up by 3:30 are automatically enrolled in the afterschool homework program. Students are asked to work quietly and are supervised by a teacher. They will receive homework help if they request it from the supervising teacher. Students who are disruptive during this time will be denied access and be asked to wait unsupervised in the front of the school for parent pick-up. Continued disruption in the afterschool homework program will result in a required pick-up at 3:30. Cost for the afterschool homework program is a maximum of \$1500 annually or \$10 per day. Parents with students still on school grounds at 3:30 are automatically billed.
