STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

The standard for conduct at Lakeside Christian School is based upon the authority of God's Word (2 Tim 3:16-17). We believe that students who profess to be Christians and understand salvation know that this requires active and willful obedience to Christ as their Lord (Jo. 14:15). We also believe that students who profess to be Christians are accountable to those in authority over them (Romans 13:1-2). There are some behaviors that the world calls acceptable, but God calls them out as sin. We do not expect our students to be perfect, but we do expect that all of our students, Christian or non-Christian, will follow the rules of conduct, accepting the consequences for any violations.

A student can be expelled from school or be asked not to return at the end of a grading period if he/she or their parents are out of harmony with the school's Statement of Faith, the spirit or the policies of the school, whether on or off the school property.

A student can be expelled without remedy if he/she exhibits a pattern of misbehavior that is considered disruptive to the school or to the classroom. This includes the violation of any stated rule and would also include any behavior that is considered by the school as non-biblical. The school will contact parents whenever such behavior occurs. The parent is expected to help their child through counseling. The school will warn one time in writing, with expulsion a potential next step if there is continuance.

In accordance with the Ministry's Statement of Faith and in recognition of biblical commands, no immoral conduct will be tolerated. The Bible strictly forbids such conduct which includes immoral behaviors or actions as well as the advocating-for or identifying-with any sinful behavior. A student can be expelled if his/her conduct, behavior, advocates for or identifies with any immoral actions. Immoral actions include all prohibitions as found in the Bible that may or may not be included in this Parent-Student Handbook. (Example: a student cannot state either verbally or by non-verbal actions, within the school, that they are an advocate-of, or they support and identify-with, or show through their behavior that they are involved in, illegal drug use.)

Students should never correct the teacher in regard to a discipline problem in front of other students. Students may follow these procedures:

- Discuss the problem privately with the teacher during break, during lunch, or after school.
- Talk the problem over with their parents and ask their parents to arrange a conference with the teacher.
- Parents may consult the administrator for a conference only after speaking with the teacher. (Matthew 18:15-17)

Students will be accepted based upon the following:

1. Parents/Guardians must read our statement of faith and then signify in writing that they understand what we believe and teach in our school.
2. Parents with students from grades 6 to 12 must meet with school administration and signify their desire to be at LCS and willingness to abide by LCS rules of behavior and conduct.
3. Parents of students in grades K5 to 5th must meet with the Elementary Principal and agree in writing to help their students understand school behavioral and academic expectations and to hold their students accountable to meeting these expectations.
4. All students are subject to entrance examinations for correct placement by grade or course level.
5. Parents agree to meet financial obligations on-time or expect to have their students suspended from classroom privileges until all past due payments are cleared.
6. All parents must comply fully with the state of Florida (HRS) immunization policy.
7. It is the policy of Lakeside Christian School not to discriminate on the basis of an applicant's race, color, sex, national or ethnic origin.
