THE SCHOOL

Lakeside Christian School is located on a 10-acre campus on Sunset Point Road in Clearwater, Florida. The school was founded in 1975 as a ministry of Lakeside Community Chapel. Lakeside Christian School is non-denominational with many churches represented in the student body. The curriculum extends from kindergarten to grade 12 and is college preparatory.

THE FACULTY

The Lakeside Christian School faculty is comprised of 22 men and women. The full-time teachers are certified and are college graduates. Several members of the faculty have advanced degrees. The teacher/student ratio is 1:12 with an average class size of 16.

ACCREDITATION

Lakeside Christian School is accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International and holds membership in ACSI, and the Florida High School Activities Association (FHSAA).

THE STUDENT BODY

Lakeside Christian School has classes for ages 5 through grade 12 with enrollment of approximately 230 students.

DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS

To graduate from Lakeside, a student must complete the following general requirements:

Bible	4 credits
Math	3 credits
History/Social Studies	3 credits
English	4 credits
Science	3 credits
Foreign Language	2 credits
Fine Arts	1 credit
Health	1 credit
Computer	1 credit
Electives	4 credits

Twenty-six credits must be earned for graduation. General and College Preparatory diplomas are available. College Preparatory requires 4 credits of Math, 4 credits of Science, 2 credits of Electives with all other requirements as listed above.

SCHOLASTIC TESTING

The Stanford Achievement Test is administered to students in kindergarten through grade 7 on a yearly basis. Students in 8th and 9th grade will take the EXPLORE test. Lakeside's students rank well above the national norms.

High school juniors and seniors are encouraged to take the SAT and ACT tests, which are used to evaluate the student's preparedness for college acceptance.

SPORTS

Lakeside Christian School is a member of the Florida High School Activities Association (FHSAA). The athletic program offers an opportunity for competing and maturing through participation in the following sports:
