The emphasis for our entire school is on college preparation. LCS exceeds the Florida State requirements for graduation, requiring a minimum of 26 credits. Honors courses are available, and Dual Credit through SPC is encouraged.

Lakeside offers Honors courses in Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, and Mathematics. Lakeside is a part of the St. Petersburg College dual enrollment program, which allows students in 10th-12th grades to earn college credits while still in high school.

In addition to the standard academic classes, Lakeside offers courses in Art History and Drama.
